8700 Rodney Ray	Known female complainant stated sometime during the daytime hours, an unknown suspect(s) made forced entry into her vehicle and stole property from within. The vehicle was parked within the parking lot area of community park.
9000 Fairbloom	Known female reportee stated a known male suspect was being aggressive and causing a disturbance at the residence.
8500 Nashwood	Deputies responded to a family disturbance type call at a residence that occurred between known male and female. The reportee stated the male and female got into a heated verbal argument which then escalated into a physical confrontation. Both male and female were arrested as a result of the investigation.
